

## Highlights

This year marked our 90th anniversary, in the historic context of the nation's Centenary of Federation, and our first UQ Ipswich graduation ceremony in December concluded a memorable year.

### Teaching and learning

- Pages 18-19** Overall student load outstripped projections and international student enrolments increased by 26.8 percent on the previous year.
- Pages 21-22** New study options increased our offerings to more than 370 programs and 5600 courses.
- Page 23** Our lecturers again won recognition in the 2001 Australian Awards for University Teaching.
- Page 26** We gave 83 University Medals to the best of our 2001 first-class honours graduates, including seven people with perfect scores of 7 and nine with 6.9.

### Research and research training
