



The Archibald Scholarship

Founded in 1911 by a gift of \$1 000 from the beneficiaries in the estate of the late Honourable John Archibald, MLC.

The scholarship is awarded annually by the Senate on the recommendation of the Head of the School of Economics.

The scholarship is awarded to the student undertaking a Bachelor of Economics (Honours) program who has, within the previous 3 years, completed ECON3010 Advanced Microeconomics and ECON3020 Advanced Macroeconomics and achieved the best overall results in these courses. The scholarship shall not be awarded more than once to any student.

The value of the scholarship is determined by the income from the fund in the year in which the award is made.
