

## **ARROW– HAWKESBURY CANOE CLASSIC PhD SCHOLARSHIP**

**The Arrow Bone Marrow Transplant Foundation (Arrow) is offering a supplementary scholarship for students commencing an Australian Postgraduate Award (APA) or comparable competitive postgraduate scholarship in 2012.**

**Students must be Australian citizens or have Permanent Residency status.**

**This biomedical research scholarship will be in the area of leukaemia and/or stem cell therapy.**

Arrow is a small charitable organisation, initially established to support bone marrow patients at St Vincent's Hospital, Sydney. It now supports research into the cause, prevention, treatment and cure of leukaemia and other diseases that are treatable through bone marrow and stem cell therapy.

Arrow also assists patients preparing for a transplant, and their families, with the management of their disease before, during and after treatment.

The scholarship will supplement postgraduate awards commencing in 2012 from the APA rate - \$22,860 in 2011, (2012 rate not yet available) up to an amount equal to the base rate of the NHMRC Medical Postgraduate Award - \$34,036 in 2011 (2012 rate not yet available).

No other allowances will be paid as part of this scholarship.

The supplement will be payable until the end of the student's 3rd enrolled year (conditions apply), with the possibility of a single 6 month extension.

Applicants must have submitted and been successful in an application for an APA or comparable scholarship award from a similar competitive scheme.

**This is not an automatic award to all successful APA recipients and is offered competitively. Arrow reserves the right to decide which schemes are comparable and whether to award two, one or no scholarships in any year.**

Applicants should submit 1 copy each of;

1. university transcript;
2. two referee reports; and
3. an outline of the proposed research project.
