The Joanna Briggs Institute is a world leader in the development and promotion of evidenced based practice. In this program, consisting of five modules, researchers and clinicians will be trained to develop, conduct and report comprehensive systematic reviews of evidence. With the aid of the Joanna Briggs Institute systematic review software (SUMARI), participants will be able to critically appraise all forms of research literature and synthesise relevant information from a variety of sources. Participants who successfully complete all five modules are certified by the **Joanna Briggs Institute** as fully competent in the systematic review process. However, individual modules can be undertaken but please note that Module 1 is a pre-requisite.

The workshops will be presented by **Dr Deborah Parker** and **Mr Brent Hodgkinson**. Both presenters have extensive experience in evidence based practice and systematic reviews.

The workshops will be given on the following dates

◆ Monday, 1 December 2008

Module 1: Introduction to Evidence Based Health Care (This module is a prerequisite for completing modules 2, 3, 4 or 5)

Participants who complete this program will be able to identify sources of evidence of the feasibility, appropriateness, meaningfulness and effectiveness of health activities and interventions, and will be able to apply this in developing a systematic review protocol.

◆ Tuesday, 2 December 2008

Module 2: Appraising, Extracting and Pooling Quantitative Evidence

Participants who complete this program will understand the process of conducting a systematic review of effectiveness and become proficient in the use of RevMan and MASTARI software.

◆ Wednesday, 3 December 2008

Module 3 & 4: Appraising, Extracting and Pooling Qualitative Evidence & from Narrative, Expert Opinion and Text

Participants who complete this program will understand how to conduct a systematic review of feasibility, appropriateness and meaningfulness using the QARI software and to enable participants to critically appraise, extract and pool evidence arising from expert opinion, narrative and text using the NOTARI software.

◆ Thursday, 4 December 2008

Module 5: Appraising, Extracting and Pooling Economic Evidence

Participants who complete this program will understand how to conduct a systematic review of economic evidence using the ACTUARI software.
