Ipswich Campus Early Offer Scheme

The University of Queensland Ipswich Campus is offering Year 12 students in the Ipswich region and Western suburbs the chance to secure early entry into its degree programs in 2010.

Who can apply?

The Early Offer Scheme is open to students in Year 12 in nominated schools who wish to apply and are considered likely to reach the OP standard applying to programs at the Ipswich Campus in 2009. Students are recommended by their schools on the basis of three semesters' of Year 11 and 12 results and anticipated OP outcome.

How do I apply?

- 1 Contact your Senior Co-ordinator/Guidance Officer to see if you meet the necessary requirements for recommendation into the scheme
- 2 Recommended students indicate their preferred program, providing they meet its entry requirements (including the usual prerequisite of a Sound Achievement in English and other prerequisites for the program)
- 3 The Principal advises UQ Ipswich by October 16 of the selected students and their chosen programs
- 4 Students lodge their QTAC Application by September 30 in the normal way, to ensure they have appropriate other options available if required
- 5 A provisional offer is made to the student, based on school recommendation, and will be confirmed in December once final Year 12 results are available
- 6 Students receive their official offer package from The University of Queensland in mid-January 2010
- 7 Students accept the offer and commence classes at the Ipswich Campus in February.

All students must also lodge a QTAC Application and nominate their six study preferences. If you are accepted into the UQ Ipswich Early Offer Scheme and change your mind, your QTAC application will still be processed in the normal way and, if you are accepted into your preferred program, you will receive your university letter of offer in early 2010.
