ROAD CLOSURE DUE TO IPSWICH 100 BIKE RIDE

Please be aware that due to the Ipswich 100 Bike Ride on this Sunday, 5th April, there will be some change to traffic conditions around the Ipswich Campus. From 6.00am to 9.00am the Salisbury Road entrance to Campus will be closed. Access will be via Parker Avenue and the boom gate will be open for this period. The direction of University Lane will be changed to allow for access. At 9.00am Salisbury Road will re-open and the Parker Avenue gate will be closed.

CHANGE MACHINE BUILDING 10

UQ Ipswich now has two change machines located outside UQ Sport Building 10. Both machines are fully operational and accept \$5, \$10 & \$20 notes.
