### **Stop Use and Replace Notice issued for fall protection devices**

All Workplace Health and Safety Officer's and workers at heights please be aware of the following information provided by Miller Fall Protection.

#### **Stop Use and Replace Notice issued for fall protection devices**

The Connecticut Department of Labor (DOL) has provided an alert regarding a Stop Use and Replace Notice issued by Miller Fall Protection. The Notice was issued for the Miller MiniLite Fall Limiter (FL11) and Titan Fall Limiter (TFL) due to an issue reported by a customer. According to Connecticut DOL, Miller is replacing all units manufactured between August 2003 and August 2005.

Miller indicates that during the period of August 2003 through August 2005 a manufacturing process was utilized that may have caused improper assembly of an internal component, which may result in the remote possibility of the unit functioning improperly in a fall. Originally it was believed this assembly procedure would not affect performance.

In August 2005, a new manufacturing process was started that was fully implemented by 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2005. Connecticut DOL reminds employers to inventory fall protection equipment to determine if they have the specified devices and take appropriate action.
