Product Info: Distributed and sold between 1984 and 1996 by CROMMELINS Machinery under these brands: *Crommelins (Model R1210); *Robin (Models R1200 & R1210); *Subaru (Model R1200); *Dunlite (Model D1210); *Nissan (Model GL 1200).

Defect Details: Improper use of the plug used with the type of 12 volt DC battery charging socket installed on the generator may allow the respective 12 Volt plug to be forcefully inserted into the 240 volt AC outlet with risk of electrocution. Affected units may carry on the Fuel Tank a label bearing a Production Number beginning with RG012.
