

The University of Queensland Travel Awards for International Collaborative Research 2011

Category 1

Guidelines and Instructions to Applicants

Applications are invited for the UQ Travel Awards for International Collaborative Research, for the promotion of interchange between The University of Queensland, Australia, and universities in other countries. **Please familiarise yourself with the following information before submitting your application. 1. General Description

The University of Queensland provides funds annually to facilitate visits to the University by scholars from other countries. Travel assistance is available to scholars actively engaged in research who will contribute substantially to research activity in the nominated School, Centre or Institute at The University of Queensland. Grants are normally reserved for suitably qualified staff of universities and internationally recognised research establishments. Other persons, however, may be considered where special circumstances exist and comparable standards are satisfied.

2. Eligibility

- (a) Any suitably qualified person who fulfils the conditions set out below is eligible for consideration.
- (b) An application from a person who has already reached Australia will not be accepted.

3. Value of the Award

- (a) The assistance consists of:
 - (i) a direct economy air fare to Brisbane, inclusive of visa fees levied by the Australian Government **for the visitor only**; and
 - (ii) subject to the visitor spending at least four weeks during semester at the University as specified in paragraph 4 (below), a return air fare **for the visitor only**.
 - (iii) In **exceptional circumstances**, and at the discretion of the selection committee, there is provision for a limited contribution to subsistence on a basis identified as genuine merit of the proposal and genuine need, to be proportionate to the length of stay.
- (b) A grant that is not taken up for a forward journey in the calendar year (1 January to 31 December) for which it is awarded, cannot be postponed. In such circumstances the grant will lapse and a fresh application must be made.

4. Conditions of Acceptance:

- (a) A grantee must normally undertake to spend at least **four weeks** during semester at The University of Queensland. (For non-medical departments the two semesters are within the period March to November (both inclusive); for some medical departments the period is slightly longer).

- (b) Assistance is intended primarily to help those persons who have secured financial support, by salaried leave or research grants, for the period of study proposed, but who would be unable to spend it overseas without help towards the cost of fares. Applicants are therefore required to give particulars of any other travel assistance held or applied for in connection with the visit. Any alteration in these particulars occurring after submission of the application must be notified immediately.

The University reserves the right to cancel or vary an offer made under this scheme if a successful candidate subsequently obtains travel assistance from another source.

5. Applications

Prospective applicants should write to the Head/Director of the appropriate School/Centre/ Institute to obtain:

- (a) more details of the School/Centre/Institute's research interests; and
(b) the prescribed application forms.
