## Boost your rank to gain entry to your preferred UQ program

The University of Queensland's Bonus Rank Scheme offers you the opportunity to improve your chance of gaining entry to your preferred program.

The scheme is designed to reward achievement, encourage skills that are highly valued by employers around the world and add to your competitive edge.



## Are you eligible?

The scheme is open to the following students:

- domestic applicants<sup>1</sup> currently completing Year 12 in Australia (including International Baccalaureate students)
- Australian citizens currently undertaking Year 12 overseas
- International applicants who are currently undertaking Year 12 in Australia

Students who are offered a place at UQ will be able to defer that offer for up to 2 years.

<sup>1</sup> domestic applicants are Australian citizens, Australian permanent residents or New Zealand citizens

## What should I study?

Year 12 students may receive up to five bonus points which are added to the 1-99 University entry rank scale. Students may receive:

- 2 points for passing a Queensland Studies Authority (or comparable interstate) language other than English (LOTE) subject<sup>2</sup>
- 2 points for passing Mathematics C or interstate equivalent<sup>3</sup> and
- 1 point for successfully completing a University-level course such as UQ's Enhanced Studies Program or a similar enrichment program via another Australian University, concurrently with their Year 12 program<sup>2</sup>

For most students there is no extra application process for the UQ Bonus Rank Scheme. Students apply to study at UQ via the Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC) and any bonus points will be automatically applied to UQ preferences.

Australian citizens who are completing Year 12 overseas may need to provide details of the curriculum for their LOTE or maths subject for UQ to assess comparability to the relevant Queensland Studies Authority subjects.

<sup>2</sup> The maximum LOTE bonus is 2 and maximum enrichment bonus is 1, regardless of how many subjects have been studied.

<sup>3</sup> ACT – Mathematics II; NSW – Mathematics 4 Unit; SA/NT – Specialist Mathematics or Maths 2; TAS – Mathematics Stage 2 & 3, or Mathematics Specialised Senior Secondary 5C; VIC – Specialist Mathematics; WA – Mathematics Specialist (MAS) Stage 3CD; International Baccalaureate – Mathematics (HL-min grade 3).

NB: The maximum number of bonus points that a student can receive under any scheme is capped at five.
