PROGRAM RULES



Graduate Diploma in Arts in Japanese Interpreting and Translation

1 Definitions

In these rules—

aptitude test means a test in translation between Japanese and English, approved by the executive dean.

2 Enrolment requirements

- (1) To enrol in the program, a person must—
 - (a) hold—
 - (i) an approved degree in any discipline; or
 - (ii) a Graduate Certificate in Japanese Interpreting; or
 - (iii) a Graduate Certificate in Japanese Translation; and
 - (b) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the person's academic record and prior work experience, the person is suitable for admission.
- (2) Applicants may be required to complete an aptitude test and demonstrate an appropriate standard to the satisfaction of the executive dean.

3 Program requirements:

To complete the program, a student must complete 16 units from the GDipAJIT course list.
