

Master of Nurse Practitioner Studies

1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) hold an approved degree in nursing (or equivalent); and
- (b) be eligible for unrestricted licence to practice as a Registered Nurse in Australia; and
- (c) five years full-time (or equivalent) recent, relevant nursing practice, as approved by the executive dean.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the MNPractSt course list, comprising—

- (a) 10 units from part A; and
- (b) 6 units from part B; and
- (c) 8 units from part C.

3 Special rules

3.1 Continuous enrolment

Unless approved by the executive dean, a student must undertake the program without interruption.

3.2 Minimum enrolment each semester

Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 4 units in each semester 1 and 2, unless otherwise approved by the executive dean.

3.3 Clinical supervision

- (1) Before commencing the program, a student must provide the head of school with written assurance of support from an approved health organisation for—
 - (a) provision of a clinical mentor; and
 - (b) clinical support team; and
 - (c) suitable professional experience to the student for the duration of the program.
- (2) Changes to the arrangements approved in subrule (1) must be approved by the head of school.

3.4 Refusal of enrolment

A student who fails the same course in part A twice will be refused further enrolment.
