1 Definitions

pre-2013 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2013.

2 Enrolment requirements

- (1) To enrol in the 24 unit program, a student must hold—
 - (a) an approved degree in the same discipline; and
 - (b) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the applicant's academic record and prior work experience, the applicant is qualified for admission.
- (2) To enrol in the 32 unit program, a student must—
 - (a) hold—
 - (i) an approved degree in any discipline; or
 - (ii) a graduate certificate or graduate diploma in urban and regional planning; and
 - (b) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the applicant's academic record and prior work experience, the student is qualified for admission.

3 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the 24 unit program, a student must complete 24 units from the MURP course list comprising—
 - (a) 16 units from part A; and
 - (b) 4 units from part C; and
 - (c) the balance from part B or part C or a combination of both.
- (2) To complete the 32 unit program, a student must complete 32 units from the MURP course list comprising—
 - (a) 20 units from part A; and
 - (b) 4 units from part C; and
 - (c) the balance from part B or part C or a combination of both.

4 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 8 units.

5 Transitional

A pre-2013 student must complete the program under the rules in force on 31 December 2012.
