1 Definitions

advanced course means a course at level 2 or higher.

approved combination means a combination of courses that is approved by the executive dean:

major means an approved combination of 16 units from the BJ course list. *minor* means an approved combination of 8 units from the BJ course list.

2 Program requirements:

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 48 units from the BJ course list, comprising—
 - (a) 16 units from part A; and
 - (b) 16 units from part B; and
 - (c) the balance from part C that may include
 - (i) a major; or
 - (ii) a minor; or
 - (iii) other combination of courses approved by the executive dean;
 - (iv) any combination of courses referred to in subrules (1)(c)(i), (1)(c)(ii) and (1)(c)(iii).
- (2) Of the 48 units required for the program as set out in subrule (1), a student must complete at least 28 units of advanced courses.
