

Bachelor of Psychological Science

1 Program requirements:

To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units from the BPsySc list, comprising—

- (a) 48 units for courses in years 1–3; and
- (b) 16 units for courses in year 4, including 6 units of thesis courses.

2 Special rules:

2.1 Progression through program

- (1) A student must commence year 4 of the program in semester one of the academic year.
- (2) A student must not enrol in year 4 of the program until gaining credit for all relevant courses in years 1, 2, and 3.
- (3) To enrol in year 4 of the program following an interruption to studies, a student must satisfy the executive dean and head of school that the student is qualified for enrolment.

2.2 Award of the bachelor of behavioural science

A student who withdraws from the program after completing years 1–3 may be awarded the bachelor of behavioural science.
