

## Master of Epidemiology

### 1 Definitions

In these rules—

*pre-2011* student means a student who commenced the program before 1 January 2011.

### 2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a student must—

- (a)
  - (i) hold an approved degree in the same discipline, with a GPA of 5; or
  - (ii) both—
    - (A) hold an approved degree in a different discipline, with a GPA of 5; and
    - (B) have completed one year full-time (or equivalent) work experience in a healthcare setting, as approved by the executive dean; or
  - (iii) hold the Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma in Epidemiology from the university (or equivalent); and
- (b)
  - (i) have completed a tertiary level quantitative research methods course, with a grade of 5; or
  - (ii) demonstrate an active contribution to a research publication; or
  - (iii) provide a report from a referee or research mentor confirming skills and experience with health-related quantitative research.

### 3 Field of study

A student must undertake the program in an approved field.

### 4 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the MEpi course list.

### 5 Transitional

A pre-2011 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2010.
