

Master of Property Studies

1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must hold—

- (a) a Graduate Certificate in Property Studies from the university or equivalent, with a GPA of 4.5; or
- (b) a bachelor's degree or equivalent, in the same discipline, approved by the executive dean, with a GPA of 4.5; or
- (c) (i) a bachelor's degree or equivalent, with a GPA of 4.5; and
 - (ii) have completed at least three years full-time work experience (or equivalent), in the same discipline, approved by the executive dean.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the MPropertySt course list, comprising—

- (a) 16 units from part A of the list; and
- (b) 8 units from part B of the list.

3 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for previous study is 12 units.

4 Special rules

4.1 Award of the Graduate Diploma in Property Studies

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 16 units from the MPropertySt course list may be awarded a Graduate Diploma in Property Studies.

4.2 Award of the Graduate Certificate in Property Studies

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 8 units from the MPropertySt course list may be awarded a Graduate Certificate in Property Studies.
