

# **Master of Advanced Economics (16 units)**

## 1 Application

These rules apply to students who are enrolled in the Master of Advanced Economics (16 units) program.

Note: a separate set of rules apply to students enrolled in the Master of Advanced Economics (24 units) program.

#### 2 Definitions

In these rules—

*MAdvEcon* (#16) *list* means the course list for the Master of Advanced Economics (16 units) program.

## 3 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program a person must

- (a) hold—
  - (i) a bachelor honours degree or equivalent in the same discipline as approved by the executive dean; or
  - (ii) a postgraduate degree in the same discipline; and
- (b) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the academic record, the person is suitably qualified for admission.

## 4 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete all 16 units from the MAdvEcon (#16) list.

### 5 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 8 units.
