PROGRAM RULES



Master of Social Work Studies (32 units)

1 Definitions

In these rules—

practicum course means a course containing a practical component where students gain supervised experience in a workplace setting.

2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must hold an approved degree.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 32 units from the MSocWkSt (32 units) course list.

4 Special rules

4.1 Full year program

- (1) A student must not enrol for courses in year 2 of the program before gaining credit for all courses in year 1.
- (2) The executive dean may decide the order in which courses are taken during each year of the program.

4.2 Practicum

- (1) A student must enrol in the program full-time for the duration of a practicum course.
- (2) A student who commences, but does not successfully complete, a practicum course may reenrol in that course in the following semester only if approved by the executive dean.

4.3 Continuous enrolment

Unless approved by the executive dean, a student must undertake the program without interruption.

5 Transitional

A transitional student may be granted credit for up to 16 units of courses undertaken in the BSocWk graduate entry program.
