

# **Bachelor of Education (Primary) (Honours)**

## 1 Definitions

In these rules—

*minor* means a combination of 6 units in courses listed in the BEd (Primary)(Honours) list; *part A; part B; part C* means the relevant part of the BEd(Primary)(Honours) course list; *practicum course* means a course whose course code includes 'EDUC' that contains a practical component where students gain supervised teaching experience in a workplace setting;

pre-2018 student means a student who enrolled in the program before 1 January 2018.

# 2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a student must-

- (a) have completed 48 units from parts A and B of the BEd(Primary) course list; and
- (b) have a GPA of 5.5 across the courses that can be credited towards the BEd(Primary)(Hons); and
- (c) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the student's academic record, the student is qualified to undertake the honours program.

#### 3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units from the BEd(Primary)(Hons) course list, comprising—

- (a) 56 units from part A; and
- (b) 6 units from Part B for a minor; and
- (c) 2 units from part B or part C.

#### 4 Class of honours

The class of honours is calculated on the basis of the grade point average of the results obtained by a student in the first attempt across 20 units of graded core courses from year 3 semester 2, year 4 semester 1, and year 4 semester 2 of the BEd(Primary)(Hons) course list.

#### 5 Special rules

#### 5.1 Award of the Bachelor of Education (Primary)

A student who withdraws from the program having completed the requirements for the bachelor pass degree may be awarded a Bachelor of Education (Primary).

#### 5.2 Concurrent study

Unless approved by the executive dean, a student must not undertake any other program outside the BEd(Primary)(Hons).

#### 5.3 Blue card

At the start of the program, a student must obtain a blue card and thereafter hold a current blue card for the duration of the program.

#### 5.4 Credit cancellation period

The credit cancellation period for the Bachelor of Education (Primary) (Honours) program is 7 years.

# 5.5 Complete final semester full-time

- (1) Unless approved by the executive dean, a student must complete the final semester (8 units) as a full-time student.
- (2) Unless approved by the executive dean, EDUC4706 and EDUC4750 must be undertaken concurrently.

## 5.6 Progression through program

- (1) A student who fails to pass a practicum course will be required to show cause to the associate dean (academic) why enrolment should not be cancelled.
- (2) A student who is required to show cause under rule 5.6(1) must do so no later than 20 business days after being required to show cause.
- (3) A student who is required to show cause may be required to attend a meeting with the head of school of education.
- (4) Show cause applications will be determined in accordance with criteria set by the associate dean (academic).
- (5) A student who has been required to show cause may have conditions set on their re-enrolment by the associate dean (academic).
- (6) A student will not be permitted to remain enrolled in the program if—
  - (a) the student fails to show cause by the due date; or
  - (b) the student's show cause application is refused; or
  - (c) the student fails to meet the conditions set on their enrolment by the associate dean (academic).
- (7) Withdrawal without academic penalty does not count as failure to pass a course.
- (8) A student who is not permitted to remain enrolled in the program under rule 5.6(6)—
  - (a) may apply for readmission into the program no less than 12 months after their enrolment has been cancelled. The executive dean may set conditions on re-enrolment.

# 5.7 LANTITE test

Prior to graduation, a student must successfully complete the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (LANTITE) as set by the Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL).

#### 5.8 Award of the Bachelor of Learning Studies (Primary) (Honours)

- A student who meets all program requirements under rule 3 but does not meet the LANTITE test requirement under rule 5.7 may be awarded the Bachelor of Learning Studies (Primary) (Honours).
- (2) The Bachelor of Learning Studies (Primary) (Honours) is not approved for teacher registration in Australia.

#### 5.9 Transitional

A pre-2018 student must comply with the requirements of rules 5.7 and 5.8.
