

## Bachelor of Agricultural Science

### 1 Definitions

In these rules—

*major* means an approved combination of 16 units from part B of the BAgrSc course list.

*residential school* means a period of attendance on campus to carry out components of a course which are not delivered externally.

### 2 Field of study

A student must undertake the program in an approved major.

### 3 Program requirements

(1) To complete the program, a student must complete 48 units from the BAgrSc course list, comprising—

- (a) 16 units for part A; and
- (b) 16 units for a major from part B ; and
- (c) 16 units from part B or part C or a combination of both.

(2) For subrule (1), a student must gain –

- (a) a minimum of 12 units of level 3 or higher courses; and
- (b) no more than 24 units of level 1 courses.

### 4 Special rules

#### 4.1 Residential schools

If enrolled in external mode, a student will be required to undertake residential schools for certain courses.
