

Bachelor of Science (BSc)

1 Definitions

In these rules—

extended major means a prescribed combination of 24 units from the extended major section of the BSc course list;

major means a prescribed combination of 16 units from the major section of the BSc course list;

minor means a prescribed combination of 8 units from the minor section of the BSc course list;

plan means a minor, major or extended major in the BSc;

UQ minor means a prescribed combination of 8 units from the UQ minor section of the BSc course list, taken as part of rule 2(1)(b).

2 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 48 units, comprising—
 - (a) 32 units from the BSc course list (excluding courses in the UQ minors list), with a minimum of 10 units of courses at level 3 or higher, comprising—
 - (i) 4 units for core courses, and
 - (ii) either-
 - (A) 16 units for a major, or
 - (B) 24 units for an extended major, and
 - (iii) the balance of units from the BSc course list (excluding courses in the UQ minors list); and
 - (b) 16 units of courses from the BSc course list or other course lists.
- (2) A student must complete no more than 24 units of level 1 courses.

3 Program plan

- (1) Each extended major must include 12 units of courses at level 3 or higher, taken from that extended major's course list and counted towards no other plan.
- (2) Each major must include 8 units of courses at level 3 or higher, taken from that major's course list and counted towards no other plan.
- (3) Each minor or UQ minor must include 4 units of courses at level 2 or higher, taken from that minor or UQ minor's course list and counted towards no other plan.
- (4) A student may complete a second major, and/or one or more minors and/or UQ minors.
- (5) Students completing the Physics major or extended major must also complete MATH1051 or MATH1071, MATH1052 or MATH1072, MATH2001, and MATH2100 in the Applied Mathematics minor.
- (6) Where the program is undertaken with more than one plan, any course listed more than once must be substituted in one plan by a course at the same level or higher from the course list for that plan, or from the BSc course list (excluding courses in the UQ minors list).

4 Maximum credit for other study:

The associate dean (academic) may only grant 6 units of credit towards the 10 units of courses at level 3 or higher, listed in rule 2(1)(a), on the basis of prior study.

5 Special rules

A student enrolled in the <u>Bachelor of Science (2030)</u> or <u>Bachelor of Science (Gatton) (2330)</u> may be permitted to enrol in this program.
