Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of #88 for the program comprising -

- #32 from the BEcon List comprising
 - o #20 of compulsory courses from Group 1 of the BEcon List; and
 - #6 from Group 2 of the BEcon List; and
 - #6 from Group 3 of the BEcon List; and
- #56 from the LLB(Hons) List comprising
 - o #40 of compulsory courses from Part A of the LLB(Hons) List; and
 - o #16 of elective courses from Parts B and/or C of the LLB(Hons) List.

Students who wish to satisfy the academic requirements for admission to the legal profession in Queensland **MUST** include LAWS5215, LAWS5216 and LAWS5217 as part of the #16 of elective courses for the LLB(Hons).

It is not possible to complete a BEcon major in this dual program.
