Bachelor of Laws (Honours) Section Requirements:

- #56 from the LLB (Hons) List including
 - #40 of compulsory courses from Part A; and
 - #16 of elective courses from Parts B and/or C.

Students who wish to satisfy the academic requirements for admission to the legal profession in Queensland **MUST** include LAWS5215, LAWS5216 and LAWS5217 as part of the #16 of elective courses for the LLB (Hons).
