To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of your program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Any courses in a declared BSocSc major that also appear in a declared BA major will be credited towards the BSocSc component of the dual degree and cannot be taken to meet the 32 units required for the BA section of the dual degree.

Students cannot take the sociology major or extended major in the BA component; or take the criminology major in the BA together with Criminal Justice in the BSocSc.

Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- ❖ 32 units from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either –
 - Two majors of 16 units each; or
 - One extended major of 24 units (28 units Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
 - One major of 16 units and two minors of 8 units each (a minor consists of 8 units in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).

- ❖ 32 units from the BSocSc list comprising -
 - 18 units from Part A
 - 12 units from Part B, comprising one major; and
 - 2 units electives
