- \#12 of elective courses from Group 3 (minimum \#6 must be at level 3, and maximum \#2 may be at level 1).


## Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

* \#32 from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either-
- Two majors of \#16 each; or
- One extended major of \#24 (\#28 Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
- One major of \#16 and two minors of \#8 each (a minor consists of \#8 in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of \#4 at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).
