<u>Please note</u>: Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of #88 for the program comprising -

- #22 of compulsory courses from Group 1 of the BBusMan List (not including LAWS1100); and
- #38 of compulsory courses from Part A of the LLB(Hons) List; and
- #12 for either-
 - one major in Group 2 of the BBusMan List including LAWS5136 (minimum #6 must be at level 3); or
 - elective courses from Group 3 of the BBusMan List including LAWS5136 (minimum #6 must be at level 3, and only #2 may be at level 1); and
- #16 of elective courses from Parts B and/or C of the LLB(Hons) List (not including LAWS5136).

Students who wish to satisfy the academic requirements for admission to the legal profession in Queensland **MUST** include LAWS5215, LAWS5216 and LAWS5217 as part of the #16 of elective courses for the LLB(Hons).
