You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Students <u>cannot</u> take the journalism and mass communication major in the BA component; or take the communication, media and culture major in the BCommun together with the media, communication and cultural studies major in the BA.

- * 32 units in accordance with the BCommun list including
 - 16 units for core courses from Part A
 - 16 units for a major from Part B

Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- ✤ 32 units from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either-
 - Two majors of 16 units each; or
 - One extended major of 24 units (28 units Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
 - One major of 16 units and two minors of 8 units each (a minor consists of 8 units in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).
