# Bachelor of Economics/Bachelor of Arts 2016 Dual Degree Program Structure

## Bachelor of Economics Requirements:

* \#36 from the BEcon List including -
- \#20 of compulsory courses from Group 1; and
- \#6 from Group 2; and
- \#6 from Group 3; and
- \#4 of elective courses from Groups 2 or 3.


## Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

* \#32 from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either-
- Two majors of \#16 each; or
- One extended major of \#24 (\#28 Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
- One major of \#16 and two minors of \#8 each (a minor consists of \#8 in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of \#4 at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).
