You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Students may not undertake the Media and Digital Cultures field of the BA component of the program.

Bachelor of Communication Requirements:

- 32 units under the BCommun course list including -
 - 20 units core courses from Part A; and
 - 12 units from one major in Part B

Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- 32 units from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either—
 - Two majors of 16 units each; or
 - One extended major of 24 units (28 units Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
 - One major of 16 units and two minors of 8 units each (a minor consists of 8 units in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).
