To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. You are not required to submit this program plan for approval. However, if you have any questions or concerns about meeting degree requirements, especially when you are nearing the end of your program, please contact the BEL Faculty for advice.

Please note: Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 88 units for the program comprising –

- 32 units from the BEcon List comprising -
 - 20 units of compulsory courses from Group 1 of the BEcon List; and
 - 6 units from Group 2 of the BEcon List; and
 - 6 units from Group 3 of the BEcon List; and
- 56 units from the LLB(Hons) List comprising -
 - 40 units of compulsory courses from Part A of the LLB(Hons) List; and
 - 16 units of elective courses from Part B of the LLB(Hons) List.

It is not possible to complete a BEcon major in this dual program.
