PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Students cannot take the Journalism and Mass Communication major in the BA component.

Bachelor of Journalism Requirements:

- ❖ 32 units in accordance with the BJ Program List including
 - 24 units from Part A; and
 - 8 units from part B

Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- ❖ 32 units from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either–
 - Two majors of 16 units each; or
 - One extended major of 24 units (28 units Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
 - One major of 16 units and two minors of 8 units each (a minor consists of 8 units in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).
