It is important that you read and understand the following information.

To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. You may have to swap courses in the plan to allow you to finish with your desired major/s - please check prerequisites and semester offerings at https://my.uq.edu.au/programs-courses/. You are not required to submit this program plan for approval. However, if you have any questions or concerns about meeting degree requirements, especially when you are nearing the end of your program, please contact the BEL Faculty for advice.

Please note: Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- You must complete a total of 72 units for the program comprising -• 20 units of compulsory courses from Group 1 of the BBusMan course list (not including ECON1010 & ECON1020); and
- 12 units for either
 - one major (except Business Economics) in Group 2 of the BBusMan course list (6 units must be at level \cap 3); or
 - elective courses from Group 3 of the BBusMan course list (6 units must be at level 3, and only 2 units 0 may be at level 1) (not including courses also listed in Group 1 of the BEcon course list); and
- 20 units of compulsory courses from Group 1 of the BEcon course list (not including ACCT1101); and
- 16 units (with at least 8 units at level 3) for either
 - one major in Group 2 of the BEcon course list (6 units must be at level 3) and 4 units of electives 0 from Group 3 of the BEcon course list; or
 - elective courses from Group 3 of the BEcon course list; and
- 4 units of general elective courses from almost any undergraduate program in the University as approved by the Executive Dean.
- → You may only include a maximum of 6 units of Level 1 courses (excluding Group 1 compulsory courses) towards the program.

You are not permitted to take the Business Economics major as part of this dual program.

If you are intending to pursue the Real Estate & Development major, please contact the BEL Faculty for advice regarding professional accreditation.
