Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 88 units for the program comprising –

- 32 units from the BEcon course list comprising -
 - 22 units of compulsory courses from Group 1; and
 - o 10 units from Group 3, with at least 6 units at level 3; and
- 56 units from the LLB(Hons) course list comprising
 - o 40 units of compulsory courses from Part A; and
 - 16 units of elective courses from Part B.

It is not possible to complete a BEcon major in this dual program.
