It is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of your program in order to graduate with both degrees. ## PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Any courses in a declared BSocSc major that also appear in a declared BA major will be credited towards the BSocSc component of the dual degree and cannot be taken to meet the 32 units required for the BA section of the dual degree.

Students cannot take the sociology major or extended major in the BA component.

### Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- ❖ 32 units from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either –
  - Two majors of 16 units each; or
  - One extended major of 24 units (28 units Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
  - One major of 16 units and two minors of 8 units each (a minor consists of 8 units in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).
