# Bachelor of Music (Honours)/ Bachelor of Education (Secondary) 2020 Dual Degree Program Structure 

Please ensure that you read and understand the following important information about your program.
To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

The Bachelor of Music (Honours)/ Bachelor of Education (Secondary) program is a five year pre-service teacher qualification that develops specialist teachers across the year levels 7-12.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. ## PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 80 units for the program.
The Bachelor of Music (Honours)/Bachelor of Education (Secondary) dual degree program prepares students to be specialist music teachers.

1. The Bachelor of Music (Honours) provides the content knowledge for teaching music in schools.
2. The Bachelor of Education (Secondary) provides the skills, knowledge and practical experience required for teacher registration and employment.

## Bachelor of Music (Honours) Section Requirements:

* 48 units from the BMus(Hons) List, comprising:
- 26 units for Part A; and
- 12 units from Part B, including MUSC3165, MUSC3840 and MUSC3890; and
- 10 units from Part C.


## Bachelor of Education (Secondary) Requirements:

* 32 units from the BEd(Sec) List, comprising:
- 16 units for Part A, including EDUC1601 and EDUC2602; and
- 8 units for Part B; and
- 4 units from Part C, comprising EDUC4645; and
- 4 units from Part C or Part D, comprising EDUC4658.

Part A teaches issues pertinent to teaching and schooling and is completed in conjunction with the requirements of the BMus (Hons) degree.

Parts B, C and D (the Professional Year) must commence in Semester One. You must complete all Bachelor of Music (Honours) and Part A BEd(Sec) requirements before you can commence the Professional Year.

This planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year. You are advised to check the scheduling for the current year and contact the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences for advice if course scheduling has changed.
