Exiting Early

Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree.

Program Requirements

Bachelor of Music (Honours) Section Requirements:

- 48 units from the BMus(Hons) List, comprising:
 - o 26 units for Core Courses; and
 - 12 units for Program Electives; and
 - o 10 units for Research Courses.

Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- 32 units from the BA course List, comprising:
 - o Two Majors of 16 units each; or
 - o One Extended Major of 24 units plus a Minor of 8 units.

To ensure you are meeting the requirements, you should refer to the Program Rules found on UQ's <u>Programs and Courses</u> website for the program, under the 'Program Requirements' heading.
