

This Program Planner is for Bachelors of Music (Honours)/Arts (BMus(Hons)/BA) students starting in 2024

### Important Information

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a **program** and a subject as a **course**.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a **full-time student**, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program.

### BMus(Hons)/BA Program Requirements

Your BMus(Hons)/BA comprises 80 units that you will complete over four years.

#### Bachelor of Music (Honours (BMus(Hons))) component requirements:

- Complete 48 units comprising -
  - 26 units for all BMus(Hons) Core Courses, and
  - 12 units for BMus(Hons) Flexible Core Courses, and
  - 10 units for all BMus(Hons) Research Courses

#### Bachelor of Arts (BA) component requirements:

- Complete 32 units from either of the two options –
  - Option 1 – Two BA Majors (16 units each); OR
  - Option 2 – One BA Extended Major (24 units) and one BA Minor (8 units)

### Additional Program Rules and information

This program requires students to enrol, pursuant to the expected program duration. Students must obtain approval to interrupt their studies. Resumption of studies may be subject to demonstrating competencies required for undertaking further study in the program. A student who fails to demonstrate competence may be required to undertake remediation which may include repeating courses and/or other requirements.

The School of Music head of school must approve changes to a student's chosen instrument for the BMus(Hons) component.

Due to course overlap, students may not undertake the Music, Music Psychology or Popular Music and Technology minors in the BA component of the dual program.

### Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a Major, Extended Major or Minor.

### Exiting Early

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 64 units, including all BMus(Hons) Core Courses from the BMus(Hons) component, and all 32 units, including at least 8 units at level 3 or higher from the BA component, may apply for and be awarded the Bachelor of Music Studies and the Bachelor of Arts.

This Program Planner assists you in drafting an enrolment plan to complete the requirements of a BMus(Hons)/BA dual as a full-time student over five years.

Read the program rules on the previous page, then add the courses that you are required to complete for both your components, and either Option 1 for your two BA Majors or Option 2 for your one BA Extended Major and one BA Minor.
