Selecting Plans in mySI-net

You may need to amend this study planner depending on the plan(s) that you have chosen to study.

Program Requirements

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) component:

- 48 units from the BCom List including
 - o 16 units for all BCom Core Courses; and
 - 16 units for one major from BCom Majors;
 - o 16 units for BCom Majors (Second Major) OR General Elective Courses

No more than 8 units can be at level 1 excluding core courses. Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.

Diploma in Languages (DipLang) component:

- · Complete 16 units for either of the following
 - o 16 units for one Major from DipLang Majors, or
 - 16 units for 2 Minors from DipLang Minors

The Program Requirements outline the requirements to complete the dual program and should be read in conjunction with the course list for the dual program. Please refer to the program and course requirements for more information.
