It is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each component of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal.

Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a field of study, major, extended major, specialisation, minor or extended minor.

Ensure the plans for your program are correctly listed in <u>mySI-net</u>. If you require assistance selecting your plan(s), follow these <u>instructions</u>.

You may need to amend this plan depending on your choice of major.

Exiting Early

Students exiting early with one component of a dual program must complete the single program requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single program requirements to complete the remaining component from that dual program.

Global Experience

If you are planning on completing an overseas exchange, you may have to amend this plan. Program Requirements

The Program Requirements outline the requirements to complete the dual program and should be read in conjunction with the course list for each component of the dual program. Please refer to the <u>program and course requirements</u> for more information.

You must complete a total of 80 units for the program.

Bachelor of Science (BSc) component:

- 32 units from the BSc List, with a minimum of 10 units of courses at level 3 or higher, including
 - o 4 units for all BSc Core Courses; and
 - o Either
 - 28 units from BSc Major Option, or
 - 28 units from BSc Extended Major Option

Selected courses must include at least 10 units at level 3 or higher.



Bachelor of Laws (Honours) (LLB(Hons)) component:

- 48 units from the LLB(Hons) List comprising -
 - 36 units for all LLB(Hons) Core Courses, and
 - 12 units from LLB(Hons) Flexible Core Courses.

- Complete a Level 3 (or higher) course towards the minor; or
- Count 2 units towards both the major and minor requirements (excluding Level 3 courses); or
- Only 2 units of prerequisite courses.

Option (a) is displayed in the study planner above.

- ² If already completed requirements for BSc minor, must complete a Level 3 course from BSc course list.
