“A” levels and STPM results are calculated on the aggregate score from a maximum of three academic courses, with A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, and E=1. This does not include General Paper scores or studies in the applicant’s first language. Advanced Supplementary level results may be included in the aggregate and contribute the equivalent of half a course taken at Advanced level, e.g. A=2.5, B=2, C=1.5, D=1, and E=0.5.

For the All India Senior School Certificate, the following numerical values are assigned to subject grades: A1 = 5, A2 = 4.5, B1 = 3.5, B2 = 3, C1 = 2, C2 = 1.5, D1 = 1, D2 = 0.5. The scores are calculated on the best of four academic subjects.
