

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You must meet academic entry requirements, individual program requirements and English language proficiency requirements to be eligible for entry into undergraduate programs at The University of Queensland.

Undergraduate entry requirements at a glance

For admission into undergraduate programs at UQ, applicants must have:

- 1 completed recognised upper secondary or equivalent Year 12 studies to the required standard (see right),
- 2 satisfied individual program requirements (ie, specific subject/course prerequisites, audition or interview) (see pages 33-82), and
- 3 satisfied English language proficiency requirements (see pages 94-95).

Academic entry requirements

To meet the University's academic entry requirements for undergraduate programs, applicants must have:

- 1 completed recognised upper secondary or equivalent Year 12 studies to the required standard (see the Minimum Australian Year 12 equivalent studies table on page 93); and
- 2 satisfied individual program requirements ie, specific prerequisites (see the Admission prerequisites and Minimum entry scores table on page 93 and program outlines on pages 33-82).

Applicants are assessed on a case-by-case basis. Meeting minimum entry requirements does not guarantee entry to the University's undergraduate programs.

Applicants who do not meet academic entry requirements may consider taking the *Certificate IV in University Preparation* offered by International Education Services (IES) (see page 29).

For dual programs

Applicants for UQ dual programs must satisfy prerequisites and entry score requirements for both programs. Students

apply via the normal application procedure (see pages 96-97). The appropriate program code for the degree combination is indicated in the tuition fees table in this prospectus (see pages 86-87).

Credit for previous study

International students who have completed post-secondary studies may request consideration for advanced standing (transfer credit) towards an undergraduate degree at The University of Queensland. Applications for credit should include full documentation of previous studies, including certified course descriptions. For more information, contact the relevant faculty (www.uq.edu.au/myadvisor).

International students awarded credit based on previous studies must maintain full-time enrolment at the University as a condition of their student visas.

Articulation programs

Articulation arrangements allow students to receive credit for previous studies, thereby gaining their UQ qualification sooner.

This does not include General Paper scores or studies in the applicant's first language. Advanced Supplementary level results may be included in the aggregate and contribute the equivalent of half a course taken at Advanced level, eg. A=2.5, B=2, C=1.5, D=1, and E=0.5.

** Pass rate of 33% overall grade in best four courses. For the All India Senior School Certificate, the following numerical values are assigned to subject grades: A1=5, A2=4.5, B1=3.5, B2=3, C1=2, C2=1.5, D1=1, D2=0.5. The scores are calculated on the best of four (ie, best four of more than four) academic subjects.
