<p><b>Offer Details</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Assessment of Applications</b></p> <p>The UQ International Admissions Section (IAS) will assess whether applicants meet the criteria for entry to undergraduate programs at UQ and make offers to eligible applicants.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>When will I get an offer?</b></p> <p>Your QTAC application details and Queensland or interstate Year 12 results are sent electronically to UQ as soon as they become available.</p> <p>All applications for international students will be assessed by the International Admissions Section. <b>If you are eligible for one of your UQ preferences you will be emailed a letter of offer in late December.</b></p>

	<p>If you receive an <b>unconditional offer</b> it means you have satisfied all the entry requirements for your program and you are ready to accept your offer.</p> <p>If you receive a <b>conditional offer</b> it means you must still satisfy one or more of the entry requirements for your program. The requirements will be listed clearly on your offer letter. In order to upgrade with tertiary study, it is recommended that you complete at least one full-time year of study with suitable results to improve your entry rank.</p> <p>Please note that the ability to 'upgrade' is not guaranteed, but it is still an option to consider.</p>

<p><b>Information for IB students</b></p>	<p>International Baccalaureate (IB) students who have achieved a specified grade in their final year will be offered credit for selected courses at The University of Queensland. In some cases, an exemption rather than credit will be offered, and the flyer (<a href="http://www.uq.edu.au/study/docs/domestic/int-bacc-credit.pdf">www.uq.edu.au/study/docs/domestic/int-bacc-credit.pdf</a>) outlines the minimum grades required, as well as further information about the University's credit arrangements.</p> <p>Credit and/or exemption may be granted for studies in English, music, psychology, mathematics, biology, chemistry, engineering or software engineering. In the majority of cases, only IB subjects taken at the Higher Level (HL) will be considered for the award of credit and/or exemption.</p> <p>If you would like to apply for credit for your IB studies, please do so after accepting your offer and enrolling your program.
