- Non-award students undertake approved courses at The University of Queensland for personal or professional development. They receive normal instruction, assessment and examination results but are not enrolled in a University of Queensland award program.
- If you wish to undertake approved courses at The University of Queensland for credit towards study at another institution, complete the Cross-Institutional Application Form.
- Non-award students are subject to the rules of The University of Queensland including those relating to late fees and academic progress. - International students undertaking non-award studies must meet the University's minimum English language proficiency requirements.
- On completion of the course, students may obtain an official academic transcript for a fee.
- Applications must be submitted by Semester 1: 31 January; Semester 2: 30 June; Summer Semester: 31 October.
- Late applications may be considered.
- Depending upon the reason for undertaking the study, students may be permitted to study up to a maximum of four courses (i.e., 8 units) per semester with a limit of eight courses (i.e., 16 units) in total being undertaken as short-term study.

Photocopies must be certified by a Justice of the Peace or by the home institution. Examination result slips or copies of degree certificates are **not** acceptable.
