About the workshop

The importance of assessment and feedback and their effect on student learning and student approaches to learning are widely acknowledged in the literature. But there is also clear evidence that our current assessment practices are generally not very good in this regard. This workshop will start by providing a theoretical model underpinning the importance of student engagement with assessment, and will then consider case study examples of how this model may be applied in practice.

Participants will be encouraged throughout the workshop to consider the potential to modify their own assessment practices, and the possibility of adopting similar approaches in their courses.

About Dr Chris Rust

Chris is Head of the Oxford Centre for Staff and Learning Development, Deputy Director of the Human Resource Directorate at Oxford Brookes University, and a Deputy Director of a HEFCE-funded, Centre for Excellence in Teaching and Learning known as ASKe (Assessment Standards Knowledge Exchange).

Chris has researched and published on a range of issues including: the experiences of new teachers in HE, the positive effects of supplemental instruction, ways of diversifying assessment, improving student performance through engagement in the assessment process, and the effectiveness of workshops as a method of staff development. He is a Fellow of SEDA (Staff and Educational Development Association), and a registered practitioner and accreditor for the UK Higher Education Academy.

This workshop is one of national series by Dr Rust, supported by the Australian Business Deans Council, the Australian Learning and Teaching Council and each host university.
