PROGRAM RULES



Graduate Certificate in Clinical Pharmacy

1 Definitions

In these rules—

recency of practice means a person has practiced as a registered pharmacist for a minimum of 300 hours in the last two years.

2 Enrolment requirements:

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) hold an approved degree; and
- (b) be registered as a pharmacist in Australia or overseas; and
- (c) have completed 2 years full-time recent relevant professional work experience; and
- (d) have demonstrated recency of practice; and
- (e) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the person's academic record and recent prior work experience, the person is qualified for admission.

3 Program requirements:

To complete the program, a student must complete 8 units from the GCClinPharm list, comprising—

- (a) 6 units from part A; and
- (b) 2 units from part B.

4 Maximum credit for other study:

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 4 units.

5 Special Rules

5.1 Comparable courses

- (a) The executive dean may allow a student to substitute courses not previously included in the GCClinPharm program requirements if the student has previously undertaken comparable courses.
- (b) Up to 4 units may be substituted under this rule.
