1. Enrolment requirements:

To enrol, a student must —

- (a) (i) for the #16 program, hold an approved degree equivalent to a 4-year degree; or
- (ii) for the #24 program, hold —
 - (A) the GDipIPH; or
 - (B) an approved degree; or
 - (C) other professional qualifications or training to the satisfaction of the head of school; and
- (b) satisfy the executive dean that the student is qualified for admission.

2. Program requirements:

#16 or #24 from the MIPH list.

3. Special rules:

3.1 **Continuous enrolment:** Unless approved by the executive dean a student must undertake the program without interruption.

3.2 **Dissertation:**

- (1) A student must obtain the approval of the program coordinator for the dissertation topic.
- (2) The head of school must appoint at least 2 examiners to examine the dissertation.
