

Master of Responsible Resource Development

1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) hold—
 - (i) an approved degree; or
 - (ii) the Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma in Responsible Resource Development; and
- (b) have completed two years' full time (or equivalent) work experience in a relevant field; and
- (c) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the person's academic record and prior work experience, the person is qualified for admission.

2 Field of study

A student may undertake the program in an approved field.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the MRespResDev course list.

4 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 8 units.
