

## Bachelor of Exercise and Nutrition Sciences (Honours)

### 1 Enrolment requirements

#### 1.1 Eligibility

To be eligible for admission in the program, a person must—

- (a) have completed the requirement for the BENS at this university, with a GPA of 5; or
- (b) have completed a 4 year qualification from the University or elsewhere and with a GPA of 4.5 and subject to the completion of additional work if set by the executive dean, satisfy the executive dean that the person is qualified to undertake the program

#### 1.2 Selection

- (1) The head of school may limit places dependent on supervisor availability.
- (2) Once eligibility is established, entry is via a competitive selection process based on GPA.

### 2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 16 units from the BENS(Hons) course list.

### 3 Class of honours

The class of honours is calculated on the basis of the grade point average of the results obtained by a student in the first attempt at all courses that contribute to the program.
