PROGRAM RULES



Graduate Certificate in Rural Development

1 Definitions

In these rules—

pre-2015 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2015.

2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) hold an approved degree; or
- (b) have completed two years of work experience in the same discipline.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 8 units from the MRuralDev course list, comprising—

- (a) 4 units from part B; and.
- (b) 4 units from part A or part B or part D or a combination of these parts.

4 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 4 units.

5 Special rules

5.1 Residential schools

A student may be required to undertake a residential school for certain courses if enrolled in external mode.

6 Transitional

A pre-2015 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2014.
